Our exclusive, semi-permanent campsites are perfectly situated at the northern end of the Chobe National Park, with some located near the iconic Chobe River. Well-worn game paths that meander past the camp heading in the direction of the river hold the promise of up-close-and-personal sightings.

2 PHOTOGRAPHIC BOATING SAFARI

Explore the bush from an entirely different perspective on a Pangolin Voyager photographic safari river boat. With eight individual 360°-rotating chairs, fitted with camera mounts, this complimentary specialist-guided half-day adventure promises the incredible opportunity to view and photograph unsuspecting wildlife from the Chobe River's water surface.

3 SAFARI ADVENTURES

Offering an interpretive safari experience, your professional &Beyond guide will tailor your game drive around your preferences. Enjoy beautiful views over the Chobe River, keeping an eye out for elephant, buffalo, and hippo, as well as crocodile, lion, fish eagle, water monitor, and black-backed jackal.

FIVE-STAR CAMPING

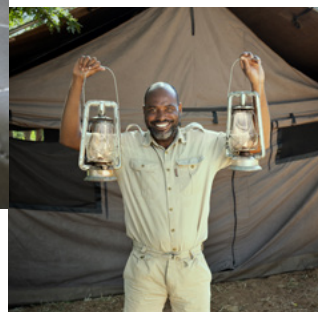

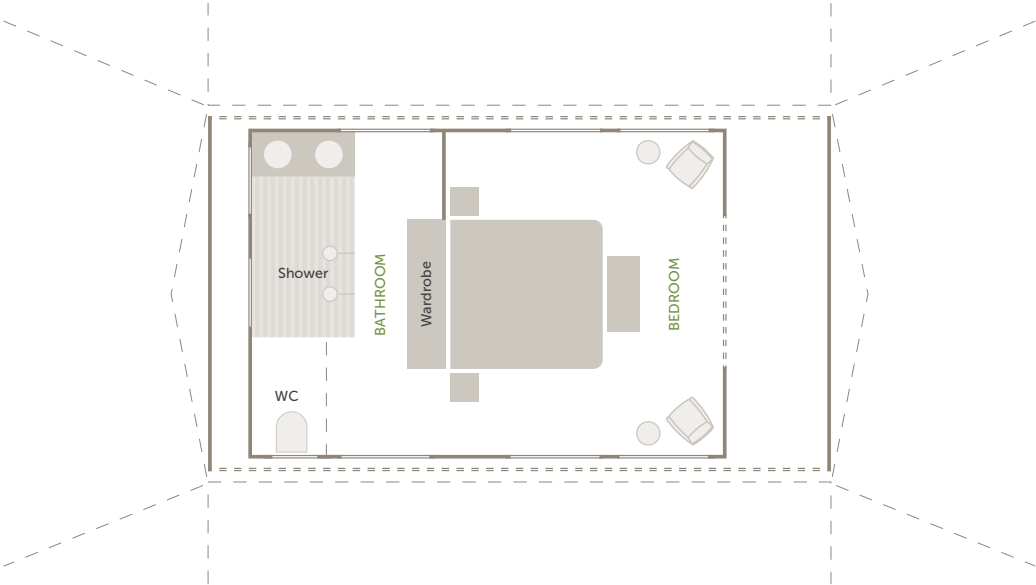

SAFARI GAME DRIVE

Enjoy twice-daily game drives exploring the wildlife-rich landscape. Home to one of the largest concentrations of elephant in Africa as well as the puku and Chobe bushbuck found nowhere else in Botswana, appreciate up-close-and-personal views of wildlife unique to the park.

BIRDWATCHING

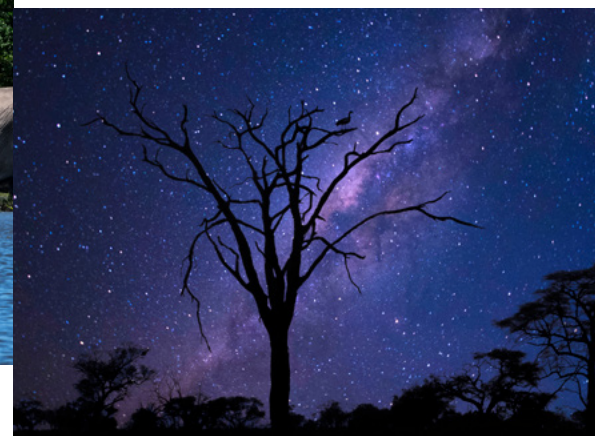
With over 450 recorded bird species, most of which are indigenous, the region is teeming with feathered inhabitants. Keep your binoculars at the ready for incredible sightings of broad-tailed paradise whydah, orange-winged pytilia, slaty egret, three-banded courser, white-fronted bee-eater, and marabou stork, amongst many other equally impressive findings.

From the moment you wake up, your &Beyond experience is tailored to your interests and needs. Your butler and guide will discuss the day with you, including timings and experiences, ensuring your day is as extraordinary as the location you are visiting. Here is what to expect on a typical day on safari in Chobe National Park.

TIMING	EXPERIENCE
Early morning	Wakeup call from your butler with hot water to wash and shower
Early morning	Enjoy breakfast at the camp
Early morning to mid-morning	Depart for morning activities: safari game drive with coffee and tea stop with snacks or Pangolin Voyager photographic safari river boat
Midday to early afternoon	Either stop for lunch en route before returning to camp or enjoy lunch at the camp Leisure time at the camp
Mid-afternoon	Afternoon High Tea at the camp
Late afternoon	Afternoon safari game drive with drinks stops and snacks
Early evening	Pre-dinner drinks and snacks around the campfire
Evening	Dinner at the camp

Travel Botswana and beyond

Travelling to Botswana requires careful consideration and attention to detail as there are a multitude of different transport methods to get to and around the country. Contact your preferred Travel Specialist to assist with your travel plans.



GETTING TO CHOBE NATIONAL PARK

Daily scheduled flights to Kasane Airport, followed by a game drive transfer to Chobe Under Canvas.

SA Airlink offer daily scheduled flights from Johannesburg (South Africa) to Kasane (Botswana).

As per national park vehicle restrictions, it is not possible for guests to self-drive to the Chobe Under Canvas camps.

Sustainability initiatives

In partnership with Wild Impact*, our long-standing community and conservation development partner.



CARE OF Land

- 155 856 plastic water bottles eliminated per year in Botswana as a result of on-site lodge and camp bottling plants
- Hybrid solar power plant systems in operation at our Botswana lodges and camps have the capacity to supply up to 80% of the lodges' energy requirements
- All our Botswana lodges and camps have sophisticated, environmentally friendly, above-ground wastewater treatment systems
- Progressive reduction of our direct carbon footprint through a system of Group goals, measured by annual lodge audits



CARE OF Wildlife

- Long-term support of the WildCRU Trans-Kalahari Predator Programme, based out of the University of Oxford, which aims to identify and protect wildlife corridors in Botswana
- Support of the Botswana Predator Conservation Trust with their African Wild Dog Dispersal Study – a project that is fundamental to the management and conservation of this endangered species
- Rhinos Without Borders – a collaboration between &Beyond and Great Plains Conservation – translocated 87 rhino from South Africa to Botswana. The significant number of calves born to these new source populations is testimony to the success of this conservation initiative



CARE OF People

- 94% of our staff complement are local Botswana citizens
- 100 training interventions held on average annually
- 89% of our Botswana camp and lodge operational expenses support local business
- The phased development of the Sexaxa Primary School from 2012 to date has been a long-term commitment by Wild Impact and &Beyond to a community-identified project
- Wild Impact's CLEF (Community Leaders Education Fund) tertiary bursary programme was introduced in 2019, with six bursaries granted to five rural students by 2020
- Two new boreholes established, providing a stable source of clean water to the isolated communities of Gogomoga and Tsutsubega



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
